

CODE OF ETHICS

- 1) I will be a good sportsman and conservationist. I recognize that people will judge all snowmobile riders by my actions. I will use my influence with other snowmobiler owners and operators to promote snowmobiling as a positive family sport.
- 2) I will not litter trails or other areas nor will I pollute streams or lakes. I will carry out what I carry in.
- 3) I will not intentionally damage living trees, shrubs, or other natural features. I will ride only when there is sufficient snow so that I will not damage the land.
- 4) I will respect other people's properties and rights. I understand that happy landowners are the key to future snowmobile trail use.
- 5) I will lend a helping hand when I see someone in need.
- 6) I will make myself and my vehicle available to assist search and rescue operations.
- 7) I will not interfere with the activities of other winter sportsmen. I will respect their right to enjoy their recreational activities as well.
- 8) I will know and obey all federal, state, and local rules regulating the operation of snowmobiles in the areas where I use my vehicle.
- 9) I will not harass wildlife, I will use my snowmobile safely at all times.
- 10) I will stay on marked trails or roads open to snowmobiles. I will not snowmobile where prohibited.
